Spanish	<p>I can:</p> <p style="text-align: center;">Listening</p> <p>*understand the main points of short spoken passages and note people's answers to questions. *follow along and repeat some words from a passage or dialogue in one time-frame *I always need to ask for things to be repeated to understand</p> <p style="text-align: center;">Speaking</p> <p>*ask and answer simple pre-learned questions from memory. *often be restricted to a couple of topics covered in class. *repeat familiar words and phrases but my pronunciation is not always understandable</p> <p style="text-align: center;">Reading</p> <p>*pick out some points and opinions in a sentence using familiar language. *use a vocabulary list to locate and understand specific words *translate individual words.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">Writing</p> <p>*write a few words in Spanish with help, giving information and simple opinions. *write some words from memory, but spelling might not always be accurate</p>	<p>I can:</p> <p style="text-align: center;">Listening</p> <p>*understand the main points of spoken passages and some of the detail *follow along and understand several key words from a passage or dialogue in one time-frame *I will regularly need to ask for things to be repeated to understand</p> <p style="text-align: center;">Speaking</p> <p>*rehearse and perform short sentences in a simple conversation *use I form of a few verbs in the present tense *produce short pre-prepared phrases on a familiar topic with more accurate pronunciation</p> <p style="text-align: center;">Reading</p> <p>*pick out the main points and opinions in a series of related sentences using familiar language. *use a vocabulary list to locate and understand a range of words *translate a few words or short sentences</p> <p style="text-align: center;">Writing</p> <p>*write several sentences with help, giving information and simple opinions. *write words and several short phrases from memory with understandable spelling</p>	<p>I can:</p> <p style="text-align: center;">Listening</p> <p>*understand the main points and opinions in spoken passages about different topics. *recognise if people are speaking in a different tense by recognising time phrases or verbs. *transcribe key words or short sentences in at least one time-frame *I may need to ask for things to be repeated from time to time</p> <p style="text-align: center;">Speaking</p> <p>*ask and answer pre-learned, memorised questions *adapt models successfully to give justified opinions *understand reference to two time-frames *produce some short phrases independently with overall good pronunciation.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">Reading</p> <p>*understand the main points and opinions in a sequence of related sentences using familiar language. *use a vocabulary list to locate and understand a range of words and put these into sentences *understand a range of tasks which include true/false statements, multiple choice, table competition, gap-fill or questions.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">Writing</p> <p>*write short, linked sentences using language from memory and giving opinions. *write a short text from memory, using simple sentences from more than one topic with fair spelling</p>	<p>I can:</p> <p style="text-align: center;">Listening</p> <p>*identify the main points and more details in spoken passages about several topics. *transcribe key words and short sentences in two time-frames *identify the meaning of a passage which includes two time-frames. I require less repetition.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">Speaking</p> <p>*give short talks, in which I express and justify my opinions *develop conversations confidently and clearly with a variety of topics. *speak about the future OR the past as well as the present. *pronounce words accurately, but with some hesitation.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">Reading</p> <p>*understand the main points, opinions, reasons and detail in a range of short texts (including poems and songs). *Use a bilingual dictionary or glossary to look up unfamiliar words. *Recognise if the texts are about at least two different time-frames *begin to figure out the meaning of more unfamiliar language in slightly more challenging texts.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">Writing</p> <p>*write short texts giving and asking for information, opinions and reasons *write in at least two time-frames. *write longer texts from memory on a variety of topics with good accuracy *translate longer passages into Spanish with increasing accuracy</p>	<p>I can:</p> <p style="text-align: center;">Listening</p> <p>*identify the main points and specific details in spoken passages about a variety of topics. *transcribe key words and short sentences in three time-frames *understand passages which include a range of structures including several time frames, and vocabulary from several familiar topics and some authentic texts.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">Speaking</p> <p>*interact confidently with familiar topics in longer conversations. Express and explain my opinions with details. *Speak spontaneously by asking unexpected questions and adding more to my answers *Speak about the past, present AND future. *pronounce words very accurately and I rarely hesitate.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">Reading</p> <p>*understand longer texts containing predictable information; including 3 time frames, and vocabulary from several familiar topics. *Use a bilingual dictionary or glossary confidently to look up unfamiliar words. *pick out and translate longer and more complex phrases into English *figure out the meaning of more unfamiliar language in more challenging texts.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">Writing</p> <p>*write short texts in a range of contexts, giving and asking for information, justifying opinions and using more complex structures *write in three time frames *write longer texts from memory on a variety of topics with accuracy *translate longer and more complex passages into Spanish with few errors</p>
