## General Rules

1. Plain black leather shoes without a heel (including wedge heels) and weather appropriate. Trainers may only be worn with school uniform when playing games outdoors, such as football or basketball, at lunchtime and after school.
2. Uniform skirts should be worn on the knee and no shorter than 2.5cm above the knee and sourced through the school outfitters.
3. Tights are to be opaque black and in good condition; torn or laddered tights are unacceptable.
4. Blazers and uniform jumpers should display the School badge.
5. Only School or plain (navy or black) scarves should be worn. Scarves should not be worn indoors with uniform. Outdoor coats should be navy or black and fall below the length of the blazer.
6. Torn, cut or scruffy clothing is not permitted and should be repaired or replaced at the earliest opportunity.
7. Jewellery should not be worn with uniform. Students with pierced lobes may wear retainer studs, up to one in each ear: two in total. Two or more earrings in one ear is not permitted. Other piercings, including nose studs, are not permitted. One single neck chain may be worn discretely under the uniform.
8. Make-up should not be obvious and boys must be clean shaven.
9. Hair should be neat, clean and of natural colour. Long hair should be tidy and preferably tied back off the face. In terms of colour, only natural highlights are permitted. Extreme styles are not permitted.
10. False nails or nail varnish of any sort is not permitted below Sixth Form.
11. Summer dress will be announced by the Heads of School with the onset of fine weather in the second half of the Summer Term. Students may wear short or rolled up sleeved shirts/blouses; trousers can be replaced by Bermuda shorts; flesh coloured tights or white ankle socks; and students should not wear blazers or ties. A smart appearance must be maintained.
12. All clothing, shoes, boots and equipment must be clearly labelled.
