

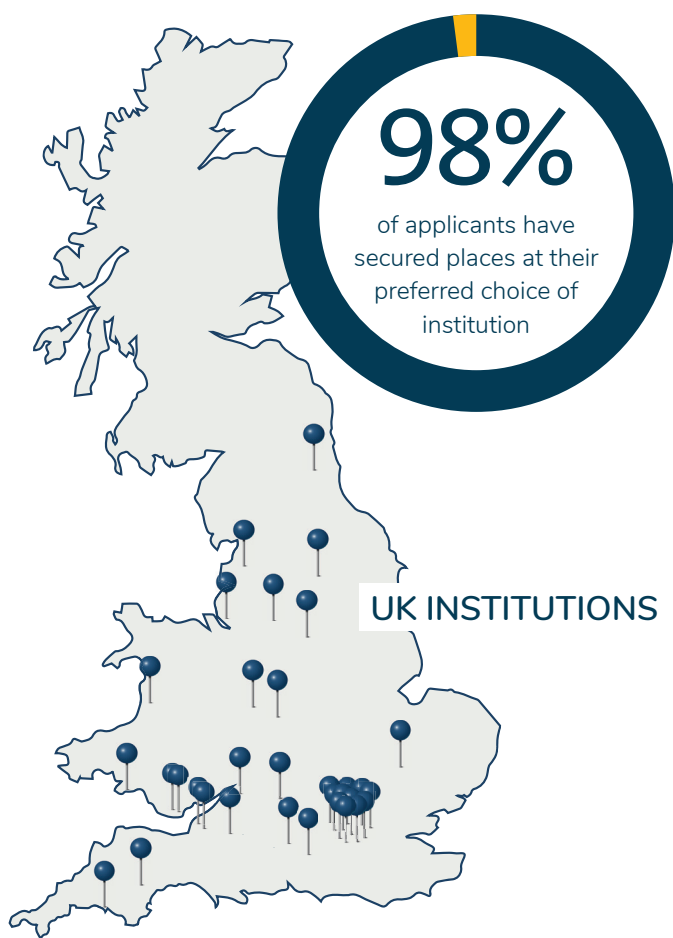
Leavers' Destinations
